### 一、评分原则

1. 本题总分为 25 分, 按 5 档次给分。
2. 评分时, 先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次, 然后以该档次的要求来衡量, 确定或调整档次, 最后给分。
3. 评分时, 应注意的主要内容为: 内容要点、应用词汇和语法的准确性、上下文的连贯性及语言的得体性。
4. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面, 评分时, 应视其对交际的影响程度予以扣分。
5. 如书写较差, 以至影响交际, 将分数降低一个档次。

### 二、内容要点:

1. 表明所尝试的事物 (必须是正面积极的, 若为负面消极的, 不能高于 10 分);
2. 描述尝试的过程;
3. 收获或感想;

### 三、要点认定:

1. 考生必须有较完整的句子表达出要点。如只有关键词而无主谓结构, 不可视为要点写出。
2. 围绕要点的发挥, 如有语言错误, 则扣语言分。

四、为了操作方便, 按表达要点是否齐全和使用语言的情况, 划分为五个档次, 列表说明如下:

档次	得分	语言情况
五	21—25	语言基本无误, 行文连贯, 表达清楚。
四	16—20	语言有少量错误, 行文基本连贯, 表达基本清楚。
三	11—15	语言有一些错误, 尚能达意。
二	6—10	语言错误很多, 影响表达。
一	0—5	只能写出与所要求内容有关的一些单词。

注意:

1. 原则上应按照考生所表达的要点数归档。如语言错误多, 可降一档, 如语言表达较好, 可打该档最高分或上升一档。
2. 在同一档次内, 根据语言错误的多少确定五个分值。  
1—2 个错误, 取该档次分值的高线 (如一档中的 24-25 分); 3 个错误, 取该档次分值的中线 (如一档中的 23 分); 4 个错误, 取该档次分值的低线 (如一档中的 21-22); 5 个错误降一档 (如二档中的 20 分)。以此类推。

## 录音原文

### 第一节

听下面 5 段对话。每段对话后有一个小题，从题中所给的 A、B、C 三个选项中选出最佳选项。听完每段对话后，你都有 10 秒钟的时间来回答有关小题和阅读下一小题。每段对话仅读一遍。

现在，你有 5 秒钟的时间阅读第 1 小题的有关内容。 (停 5 秒)

M: John is called a daydreamer. However, I think he has come up with a lot of good ideas.

W: Anyhow, good ideas need practising. (停 10 秒)

W: Did you hear the weather forecast for tomorrow? Is it going to be windy?

M: No. There would be high clouds in the morning and heavy showers in the afternoon and evening. (停 10 秒)

M: I'm looking forward to your performance tonight. It starts at 8 o'clock, doesn't it?

W: Actually, it starts one hour early.

M: Well, then I'll leave home at 6 o'clock. (停 10 秒)

M: Do you want the same cut as last time?

W: The same on top, but I'd like it a little longer over the ears. I saw this style in a fashion magazine. It's really cool. (停 10 秒)

M: Have you read John Harrison's latest book, Going Round the Worlds.

W: No. How do you feel about it?

M: Well, I laughed out loud all the way through. I want to read it again. (停 5 秒)
