## 一、评分原则

1. 本题总分为 25 分，按 5 档次给分。
2. 评分时，先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次，然后以该档次的要求来衡量，确定或调整档次，最后给分。
3. 评分时，应注意的主要内容为：内容要点、应用词汇和语法的准确性、上下文的连贯性及语言的得体性。
4. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面，评分时，应视其对交际的影响程度予以扣分。
5. 如书写较差，以至影响交际，将分数降低一个档次。

## 二、内容要点：

1. 适当的开头；
2. 2-3 点阅读的乐趣或启迪；
3. 发出倡议；

## 三、要点认定：

1. 考生必须有较完整的句子表达出要点。如只有关键词而无主谓结构，不可视为要点写出。
2. 围绕要点的发挥，如有语言错误，则扣语言分。

四、为了操作方便，按表达要点是否齐全和使用语言的情况，划分为五个档次，列表说明如下：

档次	得分	语言情况
五	21—25	语言基本无误，行文连贯，表达清楚。
四	16—20	语言有少量错误，行文基本连贯，表达基本清楚。
三	11—15	语言有一些错误，尚能达意。
二	6—10	语言错误很多，影响表达。
一	0—5	只能写出与所要求内容有关的一些单词。

## 注意：

1. 原则上应按照考生所表达的要点数归档。如语言错误多，可降一档，如语言表达较好，可打该档最高分或上升一档。
2. 在同一档次内，根据语言错误的多少确定五个分值。  
1—2 个错误，取该档次分值的高线（如一档中的 24-25 分）；3 个错误，取该档次分值的中线（如一档中的 23 分）；4 个错误，取该档次分值的低线（如一档中的 21-22）；5 个错误降一档（如二档中的 20 分）。以此类推。
