**A 篇:文章介绍了四个不同的旅游景点。**

21. A 【解析】推理判断题。根据第二段第二句可知,中国大运河博物馆收藏了大量书法作品、

绘画作品和陶器。因此,该博物馆最可能吸引艺术爱好者。

22. B 【解析】细节理解题。根据第三段第二句可知,在金门高地国家公园,游客可以在广阔的草原上远足。

23. D 【解析】细节理解题。根据最后两段可知,爱德华王子岛拥有丰富的自然景观和受欢迎的历史地标;安德茂瀑布作为自然奇观,对当地社区具有文化和历史意义。因此,这两个旅游景点都突出了自然与历史的结合。

24—27 CBAA

**B 篇:生活在多元文化家庭中,作者经历了从困惑到自我接纳的过程。**

24. C 【解析】细节理解题。根据第二段最后一句可知,作者因游离于多种文化之间而感到无处归属。

25. B 【解析】细节理解题。根据第三段第二句可知,作者的家庭的晚餐时间比大多数阿根廷家庭的晚餐时间更早。

26. A 【解析】推理判断题。根据最后一段最后两句可知,作者最终将多元文化身份视为一种礼物,它赋予了作者更多的家、更多的传统和更广阔的视野。因此,作者最后将自己的多元文化身份视为一次丰富人生的体验。

27. A 【解析】主旨大意题。文章的主要内容:生活在多元文化家庭中,作者经历了从困惑到自我接纳的历程。因此,“A Multicultural Identity’s Journey”为文章的最佳标题。

**C 篇:人类将效仿祖先重返海洋,开启文明新篇章。**

28. C 【解析】词义推测题。通读文章可知,该公司希望在海底建造可供人类永久居住的住所。由此可推知,subaqueous 意为“水下的”。

29. D 【解析】推理判断题。根据第二、三段可知,早期的海底实验室和该公司的海底基地都是为了让人能在海底生活而建造的。

30. B 【解析】推理判断题。根据第四段 Nancy Knowlton 说的话可知,她担心该公司的计划可能会引发新问题。因此,她对该公司的计划是持怀疑态度的。

31. C 【解析】推理判断题。根据最后一段第一句可知,该公司有远大的梦想,并计划到 2035 年在世界范围内建立十个水下基地,以及到 2050 年迎接第一个在海底诞生的“宝宝”。因此,这是一个宏大的计划。

32—35 BDDA

**D 篇:文章介绍了恒星在早期宇宙中的形成过程以及分子云的形态对恒星形成的影响。**

32. B 【解析】推理判断题。根据第一段可知,作者通过描述恒星在恒星孕育区形成的自然过程来引入文章主题。

33. D 【解析】细节理解题。根据第二段可知,研究员通过观察 SMC(小麦哲伦星系)发现早期宇宙中的恒星可能在软分子云中形成。因此,该研究主要关注早期宇宙中的恒星形成。

34. D 【解析】细节理解题。根据第四段最后一句可知,薄分子云内部的温度高于软分子云内部的温度,这可能是因为它们的年龄不同。

35. A 【解析】主旨大意题。最后一段主要强调了分子云的形状和重元素是恒星形成的前提条件。

36—40 GCBDE

**七选五:文章介绍了在数字时代改善数字健康的建议。**

36. G 【解析】上文提到查看手机消息会影响你完成任务,导致错误率上升且让你需要额外时间恢复专注。G项“因此,关闭不必要的通知以减少干扰,提升专注力”呼应了减少干扰的主题,与上文内容紧密相连,是合理的过渡句。

37. C 【解析】上文强调了有序环境的重要性,下文提到设立数字界限并与他人沟通。因此,C项“为了更好地掌握数字生活,行动起来”与上下文逻辑连贯,符合语境。

38. B 【解析】本段讨论了技术对生活的影响取决于其使用方式,并且建议限制社交媒体使用时间。因此,B项“控制每日上网时间”符合段落主题。

39. D 【解析】上文提到在早上规划一天的任务和计划,下文提到设置屏幕使用时间。因此,D项“考虑一种计划来设定你想要的上网时长”起到承上启下的作用,符合语境。

40. E 【解析】下文提到在线联系人可能浅薄或不真诚,你应当优先考虑有意义的关系。E项“社交媒体可能是焦虑和社交比较的来源”引出下文,符合语境。

43. A 【解析】考查动词。十五年来,患有唐氏综合征的 Christina 大部分时间都不会说话,租影片已经成为她日常生活的重要组成部分。

44. C 【解析】考查名词。Christina 一直与音像制品出租店有着很深的联系,她把每家店都和她最喜欢的电影联系在一起。

50. B 【解析】考查动词。在收银台留下电话号码时,她总会等待员工逐一复述每个数字,然后再继续——他们很高兴地接受了这个过程。

52. D 【解析】考查动词。虽然新的租赁角落将向其他值得信赖的顾客开放,但正是 Christina

53. A 【解析】考查名词。当 Toni 第一次看到这个设置时,她亲切地称之为“Christina 的角落”。

54. B 【解析】考查名词。Toni 感激万分,表达了她对 Kraning 和他的团队的感激之情。

55. D 【解析】考查动词。她说:“当你看到社区里的人们互相照顾时,你的心怎么能不融化呢?”

56. officially 【解析】考查副词。此处应用副词 officially 修饰动词 opened。

57. inspired 【解析】考查非谓语动词。根据句子结构和空后的 by 可知,此处应用过去分词 inspired 作后置定语。

58. an 【解析】考查冠词。area 的发音以元音音素开头,故此处应用 an,表泛指。an area of... 意为“……的面积”。

59. as 【解析】考查介词。根据句意可知,此处应用介词 as,意为“作为”。

60. popularity 【解析】考查词性转换。根据空前的介词 in 可知,此处应用名词 popularity。

61. gaining 【解析】考查非谓语动词。分析句子结构可知,gain 与 It 是逻辑上的主谓关系,故此处应用其现在分词形式。

62. zones 【解析】考查名词单复数。根据上文中的 nine 可知,此处应用名词复数 zones。

63. to take 【解析】考查非谓语动词。allow 后面常接不定式作宾语补足语。

64. which 【解析】考查定语从句。分析句子结构可知,此处应用关系代词 which 引导非限制性定语从句,且 which 在从句中作主语,先行词是 The “Snow Disco” event。

65. was held 【解析】考查时态和语态。hold 与句子主语 The “Snow Disco” event 之间是被动关系,且此处描述的是过去发生的事件,所以要用一般过去时的被动语态。

——比较有效地使用了语句间衔接手段,全文结构比较清晰,意义比较连贯。

达到了预期的写作目的。

第三档(7—9 分)

——覆盖了大部分内容要点,有个别地方表述不够清楚、合理。

——使用了简单的词汇和语法结构,有一些错误或不恰当之处,但基本不影响理解。

——基本有效地使用了语句间衔接手段,全文结构基本清晰,意义基本连贯。

基本达到了预期的写作目的。

第二档(4—6 分)

- 遗漏或未清楚表述一些内容要点,或一些内容与写作目的不相关。
- 所使用的词汇有限,语法结构单调,错误较多,影响理解。
- 几乎不能有效地使用语句间衔接手段,全文结构不够清晰,意义不够连贯。
- 未能达到预期的写作目的。

#### 第一档(1—3分)

- 遗漏或未清楚表述大部分内容要点,或大部分内容与写作目的不相关。
- 所使用的词汇有限,语法结构单调,错误很多,严重影响理解。
- 几乎没有使用语句间衔接手段,全文结构不清晰,意义不连贯。
- 完全未达到预期的写作目的。

- 使用了比较多样并且恰当的词汇和语法结构,可能有些许错误,但不影响理解。
- 比较有效地使用了语句间衔接手段,全文结构比较清晰,意义比较连贯。

第三档(11—15分)

- 创造了基本合理的内容,有一定的逻辑性,续写基本完整,与原文情境相关。
- 使用了简单的词汇和语法结构,有一些错误或不恰当之处,但基本不影响理解。
- 基本有效地使用了语句间衔接手段,全文结构基本清晰,意义基本连贯。

第二档(6—10分)

- 内容或逻辑上有一些重大问题,续写不够完整,与原文情境有一定程度脱节。
- 所使用的词汇有限,语法结构单调,错误较多,影响理解。
- 未能有效地使用语句间衔接手段,全文结构不够清晰,意义不够连贯。
